

Membership categories and membership rates 2019

Any organization that has links to biotechnology can be a HollandBIO member; dedicated R&D biotech companies as well as services providers. HollandBIO works with different membership categories, based on the type of company and on whether or not a company has sales revenues. The membership rates are inflation-adjusted on a yearly basis¹. The HollandBIO board decides on the admission and the type of membership.

Biotechnology members

Biotech members are companies that have biotechnology as a core-business. For instance, companies that develop medical, industrial, agri-food or environmental products. The membership fee for these companies depend on sales revenues made by the Dutch BV/NV in 2016. Biotech companies with a sales revenue by the Dutch BV/NV below €25 million are categorized by their number of employees at the 1st of January 2019. A company which is established after 2014 and which does yet make a revenue, will be categorized as a start-up company.
