


Budgets for prevention and vaccination are low across the EU.

Vaccinating an individual against up to 17 diseases throughout their entire life has been estimated to cost only around €3,395 (including administration costs).






Vaccination is key to increasing healthcare system resilience.






Vaccines save lives and have led to the eradication or control of many infectious diseases.






Vaccines reduce the use of antimicrobials by 47% and protect against drug resistant forms of diseases.
